Where do I buy tickets?

How do I get to all the venues? (Note — maps are on the reverse side)

JACKSON THEATER at SONOMA COUNTRY DAY SCHOOL

Take the Airport Boulevard exit and head west. Turn right at the first traffic light onto Aviation Boulevard. Go approximately 1/2 mile, turn right on Day School Place. Enter Sonoma Country Day School through the main school doors, the Jackson Theater is directly ahead.

THE RAVEN THEATER

From the northwest corner of the Healdsburg Plaza (Healdsburg Avenue and Plaza St.), go 1 block north to North St.; turn right on North, to 115 North Street.

HOTEL HEALDSBURG and DRY CREEK KITCHEN

The Hotel and Kitchen face Healdsburg Avenue, directly across the street from the west edge of the Plaza.

SODA ROCK WINERY 8015 Hwy 128 in Alexander Valley, about 1.5 miles from the Jimtown Store.

DAVIS FAMILY VINEYARDS 52 Front Street, Healdsburg, just north of Memorial Bridge.

PAUL MAHDER GALLERY -- 222 Healdsburg Avenue, across the street from H2H and SPOONBAR.

SPOONBAR – 219 Healdsburg Avenue, ground level next to lobby of H2H.

Where do I park?

There is ample free parking near the Jackson and Raven Theaters, behind Hotel Healdsburg, the Mahder Gallery, Spoonbar, and at the winery venues.

When do the doors/gates open?

Doors to the lobby at the Jackson and Raven theaters open one hour before showtime. For all other venues the doors open 1/2 hour before showtime.

How early can I get there?

We recommend arriving 1/2 hour before the doors open to get a good place in line, unless seating is reserved.

Can I bring food or drink?

You can bring food and drink to the Plaza. No alcohol may be brought in to any venue, indoor or outdoor.

Will there be food and drink for purchase?

Wine and water are available for purchase at all events. Food and wine will be available for purchase at Soda Rock Winery and Davis Family Vineyards.

Are kids allowed? Yes.

Cameras? There is absolutely no photography, videotaping, or audio recording allowed at any of the performances.

When will I get my tickets? Ticketing is handled through Vendini. You can print your tickets at home, store them on your mobile device, or pick them up at Will Call. You can also request physical tickets to be mailed to you for \$2.

Where do I pick up Will-Call tickets? There will be a Will-Call table near the entrance at each venue.
